

SAFETY RULES

The following rules must be followed by all members of the club.

1. No jewellery of any kind are allowed whilst training or playing netball.
2. Wear a quality pair of netball shoes and socks.
3. Never play if there is any type of debris on the court.
4. Ensure the area around the court is clear and safe.
5. Spectators, loose gravel, or other obstacles could be dangerous if players wander out-of-bounds.
6. Check the netball net is fixed at the proper height and secured in the correct position.
7. Hair should be pulled back with a soft hair band - no big/hard plastic clips are permitted.
8. No food may be consumed in the sports hall or on outdoor courts.
9. Drinks (appropriate for fluid replacement during strenuous activity) are permissible in non-breakable containers, but any spillages that occur in the sports hall must be reported.
10. Parents are welcome to stay and watch the sessions but must sit in the permitted viewing area (inside) or ensure they are away from the court boundaries (outside).
11. Parents must pick up students at the end of class time.
12. Do not interrupt the coach once the session has begun.
13. Do not bring sick children to training.
14. Do not climb on raised mats, play with ropes or try to access storage areas within the sports hall.
15. The netball court is a place for positive actions and communication. If you have any concerns or problems, talk ONLY with the coach at the appropriate time and place.
