

## **Safeguarding Reporting Procedure**

The club is committed to providing a safe environment for children to play netball. All coaches will undertake safeguarding qualifications and the club will appoint a safeguarding lead.

The club follows the advice of the NSPCC's Child Protection in Sport Unit's *Safeguarding Reporting Procedure Flowcharts, which* provide guidance for organisations on reporting concerns for the following situations:

- 1. The behaviour of an organisation's staff member or volunteer (for example, allegations about a coach or officer's behaviour toward a child)
- 2. The behaviour of another organisation's staff member or volunteer (such as allegations reported about an individual working for a partner organisation)
- 3. Concerns about children and young people arising out of sport (at home, school or within the community).
